REGISTRATION: Held in the Kirk Center at Olivet College. Check-in times are 1:00 to 2:00 pm., Michigan time (Eastern Daylight Time). Check-out time is 4:30 pm. Needed the day of registration: HEALTH FORM. BALANCE DUE should be paid, but if not, must be collected at registration. Credit cards will not be accepted the day of registration.

SESSION DATES: Tuesday, July 6 (1:00 to 2:00 pm. Check-in) **through Friday, July 9** (4:30 pm.)
Three sessions available: SHOOTING CAMP; GOLD CAMP (advanced high school); JUNIOR GOLD CAMP (advanced middle school)

SESSION DATES: Sunday, July 25 (1:00 to 2:00 pm. Check-in) **through Wednesday, July 28** (4:30 pm.)
Three sessions available: COMPLETE SKILLS CAMP; SHOOTING CAMP; JUNIOR GOLD CAMP (advanced middle school)

AWARDS PRESENTATION – Begins at 3:30 pm. on the last day of camp
CHECK-OUT is at 4:30 pm.

HEALTH REPORT: Parents must complete and sign the camp health form; be sure to include the name of your medical insurance company. Please bring this form to camp. DO NOT MAIL. If you have special medicines to take, bring them with written instructions on the reverse side of the health report.

WHAT TO BRING: Basketball gear – shorts, shirts, socks, two pairs of basketball shoes. Casual wear – jeans, shorts, T-shirts, jacket or sweatshirt, pajamas, swimsuit. Miscellaneous articles – towels, sheets pillow, two blankets or sleeping bag, toilet articles, and a fan. PLEASE MARK YOUR CLOTHING FOR IDENTIFICATION. We are not responsible for articles lost or stolen at camp. Please leave all jewelry at home. All meals are provided and water is available, but you are also welcome to bring bottled water, sports drinks and snacks.

ROOM KEYS: Available upon request at check-in time for a \$20.00 deposit. This deposit is totally refundable if the key is returned at check-out time. The deposit is forfeited if the key is lost. On rare occasions there may be only one key available for a room.

CELL PHONES: Campers are allowed to bring a cell phone to camp. The phones must be kept in the dorm room and can only be used there (not in the gym, cafeteria, etc.). Please talk to your child about using them only to communicate important camp information (pick-up time, game schedule, etc.). We would also hope that you, as parents, keep calls to your child to a minimum. Part of the camp experience that can be most beneficial to young people is giving them the chance to get away and to be on their own. Of course, a cell phone is not necessary. There are pay phones available, and the Site Director will get in touch with parents, or make a phone available to any camper, should the need arise.

PICTURES: A group picture of the campers may be ordered at check-in time for a fee of \$7.00. The picture will be handed out before the end of the camp session.

DAY CAMPERS: Day campers will register at the same time as the regular campers and remain for the rest of the first day. Each day thereafter the camper arrives after breakfast and stays until 9:45 pm, with lunch and dinner provided.

CAMP MAIL: If you want to receive mail at camp, it should be addressed as follows: camper's name, c/o McCracken Basketball Camp, Olivet College, Olivet, Michigan 49076.

CAMP BANK: Spending money may be turned in to the camp bank at the first meeting following registration. The bank is open each day so that money may be withdrawn.

EMERGENCIES: For an emergency only, please call the college conference office at: 269-749-7197.

CAMP LOCATION: On the campus of Olivet College in Olivet, Michigan. The college is located in south central Michigan, 20 miles south of Lansing and 125 miles west of Detroit. The college is easily accessible from I-69. A map to the college is included in this packet.

COUNSELORS: An adequate number of trained counselors will live in dormitories with the campers and, along with the director and assistant director, will supervise all camp activities

MEDICAL CARE: Complete first aid facilities are available. A hospital with 24-hour emergency service is located nearby.

FACILITIES: Campers will be housed in college dormitories (two to a room). All meals will be served in the college cafeteria. A large, indoor swimming pool is available on campus. Basketball instruction and play will take place in Upton and McKay gymnasiums.

CANCELLATION POLICY: If you have to cancel, for any reason, we will issue you a camp credit for all camp fees paid, valid through 2011 and is transferable to any family member and may be used at any McCracken basketball or volleyball camp.
